You are absolutely correct - this DOES NOT work. I have "Content Only" selected, and I still get this.

Out of sheer frustration, I just commented out the code (from around line 139 to line 157, give or take, in alphacontent.class.php). I strongly suspect a logic error in the controlling conditional, as I'm not getting any PHP error messages or notices.

I don't have time to troubleshoot, as the creator knows his codebase far better than I do, so I took the easy route. B)

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
