I have both chronoforms and mxcomment installed. I run my Joomla 1.5.9 in Legacy.

When i go to

- Extensions
- install/uninstall
- components

I see maxcomment: not compatible

What they mean is maxcomment is not compatible with joomla 1.5 with legacy turned off. But I have legacy turned on and still get this message.
